### THE DISABILITY TRUST RAP 2021-2022

Calling for Expressions of Interest (EOI) from First Nations artists with a disability.

The Disability Trust is a disability support provider, offering services on Yuggera, Bundjalung, Kuringgai, Worimi, Wonnarua, Darkinung, Awabakal, Eora, Dharug, Dharawal/Tharawal, Ngunawal, Gundungurra, Wiradjuri, Ngarigo, Yuin, Bidwell, Wathaurong, Boonwurrung and Woiworung Countries. We are just starting on our Reconciliation journey, and are looking for a First Nations artist with a disability to commission our artwork for our Reflect Reconciliation Action Plan.

### PURPOSE

This EOI is for the procurement of a single piece of artwork, and for the intellectual property rights to digitally reproduce all or part of the piece. The artwork would need to be approximately 100cm x 75cm, landscape orientation, and painted on canvas.

### CONCEPT AND KEY THEMES

First Nations artists with a disability who are also TDT participants or employees are encouraged to apply. The aim of the artwork is to provide a visual representation of Reconciliation within the Disability Sector:

- Reconciliation - respect, relationships, opportunities
- Disability sector - social and emotional wellbeing, inclusion, participation, what it means to you to be part of the Disability Trust (either as an employee or participant)

It would also be great to include the colours within the Disability Trust brand, or colours that would be complementary.

### SUBMITTING AN EOI

Artists are requested to submit concept designs as an email attachment (drawings/photos accepted), along with a written concept design and statement/story explanation of how your piece ties in with the key themes above.

Individual and collaborative works would be accepted.

The successful applicant/s will be announced by Friday 26th March, 2021.

Submission and delivery of the final artwork by the successful applicant will be due by Friday 16th April, 2021.

### SUCCESSFUL SUBMISSION

The successful applicant/s will be eligible to receive a commission fee of \$3000 GST exclusive, upon delivery of final artwork. Please note, the final artwork piece and intellectual property rights to digitally reproduce all or part of the artwork, for which the stated fee is paid, will be the property of The Disability Trust.
